We take allegations against counter parties very seriously, review them, and take action based on the findings of our reviews.

BP requires compliance with anti-corruption laws and does not tolerate corruption in any form. Our ethics and compliance programme employs anti-corruption safeguards, such as performing due diligence on prospective suppliers, contractually requiring them to comply with relevant laws and requiring them to maintain their own internal safeguards. We also train our staff to watch for and raise possible concerns, investigate relevant allegations, and take action in response to findings.

BP has made a significant and long-term commitment to Senegal and, in common with our businesses around the world, will operate to the high ethical standards contained in our Code of Conduct.
